In any instance, the humility and integrity as individuals comes into question when there is a clear misrepresentation of character, ethics, and pure dignity taken by our classmates and colleagues. For the sole purpose of withholding past precedent, we, the ACTION Party, are calling for an appeal of the election process. On the basis of loophole utilization to inhibit an unfair campaign process.

Four years ago, Presidential candidate Juan Cubillo was disqualified for handing out platform cards in North Lake. This set a precedent that ultimately should have been amended to the election code, however, despite the fact that for some reason it was not, the precedent still stands and should not be subject to objectivity if another party were to do what disqualified the aforementioned party. Given that substantial proof (ie. Videos and photos) was forwarded to supervisor of Elections, Montana Knight), there should have been repercussions for the Soar party's active campaigning in South Lake Village. However, no action was taken on these offenses, instead they were dismissed, as it was a "gray area" in the election code, by Student Government advisor, Julie Gleason. Gleason however, did not inform the ACTION party that this behavior was allegedly deemed acceptable. Causing a disadvantage to the party.

There seems to be a misuse of power at multiple levels. Presidential candidate, Jalisa White, was found to be using Student Government equipment to campaign, and allegedly lost tabling time. However, the entirety of her party was allowed to continue, both on main campus and housing. This also contradicts the precedent set in prior election cycles, where if tabling time was lost, it applied to the entire party.

Additionally, the total provided on the official election results sheet, is not proportionate to the percentages that are shown on the sheet. This gives the impression that the sheet is not the official result page, but rather a poorly calculated, hand typed document.

To conclude. We, the ACTION Party, are appealing the Student Government Election Results from March 1st, 2018. On the grounds of misinterpretation of the election code to benefit the SOAR Party, the SOAR Party's use of Student Government equipment without facing repercussions and the totals of the election results being disproportionate to the overall total provided.
